

Age/Division Draft Rules and Other Information

Age 9 **(10-year-olds refer to page 2)**

Welcome to Salmon Creek Little League! We hope you and your child have an enjoyable season. To help you get started, we have compiled the following information:

- Division:** It is our intention that 9-year-olds play in our Pac Coast (PC) division, but some who are not drafted may play in NW. Players age 9 will be given preference over any 8-year-olds wishing to play up. Divisional placement will be based on age and on players being drafted – i.e. players drafted by a PC team will play in the PC division. **If you do have any concerns about the division your child plays in, please contact the player agent listed below prior to tryouts.**
- Try-outs:** All 9-year-olds will need to try out. See the Calendar page (<http://salmoncreekll.com/calendar>) for time, date, and location of try outs. All players will be placed on a team. **Please check www.SalmonCreekLL.com for further information.**
- Draft:** All 9-year-olds are drafted onto teams by the coaches, thus parents cannot request a particular coach at the PC level. For siblings in the same division, parents can request that they be drafted onto the same team (“brother/sister-option”).
- Teams:** Your child will be placed on a team by mid February. Please call us (see numbers below) if you have not heard from a coach by February 15th.
- Practices:** Practices can begin 30 days before opening day. Before the season starts, practices are generally held two times a week - generally once on a weekday and one on Saturday. It is up to your coach to decide how many practices teams will hold once the games begin. You should expect your child to practice at least once or twice/week during season play.
- Games:** Games will begin on March 17th. Games are played twice a week – usually once on a weekday and once on Saturday. Games generally last about 2 hours. Players should be at the field one half hour before the game starts.
- Uniform:** The League provides the hat and Jersey. Your coach will let you know what color sock, undershirt and pants to buy.
- Equipment:** Your 9-year-old will need a baseball glove/mitt and baseball cleats. Personal bats are optional, but must meet little league specifications (see LL rule book). Athletic supporters and cups are required. Personal helmets are encouraged. Shorts are not allowed.
- Opening Day:** SCLL will celebrate our opening day on Saturday, March 17th. Opening Ceremonies start at 10am. Players should show up in uniform and be ready to play. Pictures will be held on March 24th.

Age 10

Welcome to Salmon Creek Little League! We hope you and your child have an enjoyable season. To help you get started, we have compiled the following information.

- Division: 10-year-olds play in our Minor league division, Pac Coast **OR may be drafted up to the National division. If you do not want your child to play Nationals for this year, you must note this on your registration form in the space provided.**
- Try-outs: All 10-year-olds will need to try out. See the Calendar page (<http://salmoncreekll.com/calendar>) for time, date, and location of try outs. All players will be placed on a team – either Pac Coast or Nationals. **Please check www.SalmonCreekLL.com for further information.**
- Draft: All 10-year-olds are drafted onto teams by the coaches, thus parents cannot request a particular coach at this level. For siblings in the same division, parents can request that they be drafted onto the same team.
- Teams: Your child will be placed on a team by mid February. Please call us (see numbers below) if you have not heard from a coach by February 15th.
- Practices: Practices can begin 30 days before opening day. Before the season starts, practices are generally held two times a week - generally once on a weekday and one on Saturday. It is up to your coach to decide how many practices teams will hold once the games begin. You should expect your child to practice at least once or twice/week during season play.
