

# SCLL 2014 National Tournament

**National** seeding is based on regular season final standings.

Inter league games do not count in the standings.

A Managers and named coaches (only) meeting will be held prior to games to discuss rules.

The National tournament will consist of a round robin tournament between all teams, with the top four teams advancing to the second round. The second round will be a double elimination tournament with a single, winner-take-all, championship game (NO "what-if" game). The home team shall occupy the 3rd base dugout.

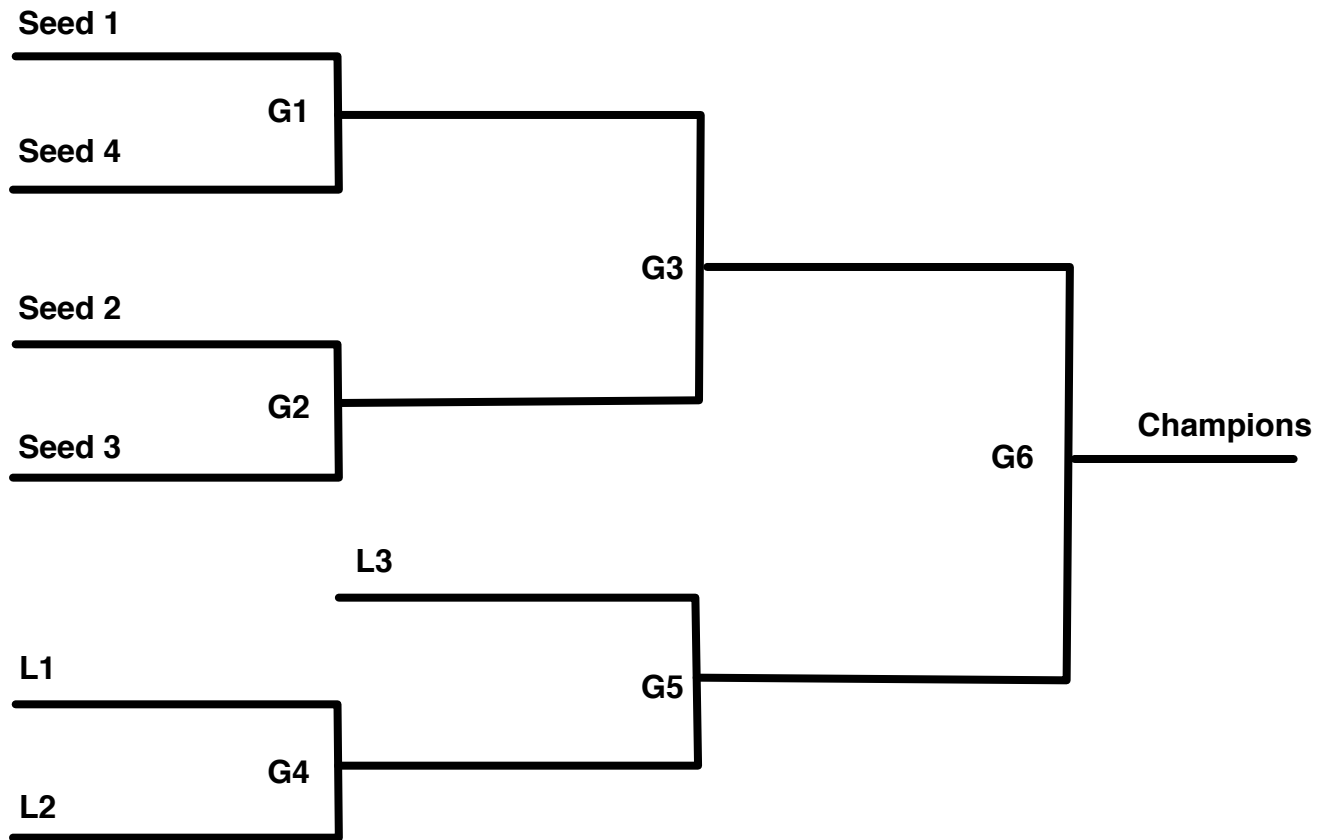
## Regular season standings

1st place	-> Seed 1 - Diamondbacks
2nd	-> Seed 2 - Mariners
3rd	-> Seed 3 - Cubs
4th	-> Seed 4 - Cardinals
5th	-> Seed 5 - Giants

In the initial round robin tournament, the higher seeded team has choice of home/visitor.

In the second round, seeding is based on the first round results and not on regular season results. The higher seeded team gets choice of home/visitor.



- If teams finish with the same record, the first tiebreaker is head-to-head record.
- The second tiebreaker is total runs allowed in head to head competition, with the lowest total runs being the winner.
- The third tiebreaker is total runs allowed in all tournament competition, with the lowest total runs being the winner.
- The final tiebreaker is the regular season standings with the highest standing ruled the winner.
- No advantage will be given to a team running up the score.
- No additional games will be played to determine tournament seeding or advancement to the semi finals.

Regular season standings determine seeding. If there is a tie in standings, tiebreaker rules from above apply.

If there are rainouts during the round robin, any game will need to be made up before June 9. Any game not made up by June 9 will be lost. Seeding for the 2nd round will be based on round robin games completed. All make up games will take place at the Gaiser fields.
