BMOD/Board Member On Duty: There is a SCLL Board member on duty each day that there is game						
play. The list will be in the concession stand and on the website. BMOD is the volunteer board member						
in charge if any problems/situations occur where help is needed beyond adults from your team being						

able to handle themselves. Example: Accident/injury, closing/locking containers/gates, or spectator problems. We always encourage you to work through your managers and other adults available but if

you need league help, the BMOD is available to you for assistance.


