

SCLL 2021 Minor A Tournament

Minor A tournament seeding will be a random draw.

A Managers meeting will be held by the commissioner the week before the tournament starts. Team names will be randomly drawn to determine the playoff seeds.

All 5 teams will be placed into a single pool playing 2 random opponents. At the end of pool play the top 4 teams advance to the semifinals. That means that one of the five teams will be eliminated.

Home team will be decided by a coin flip. The home team shall occupy the 3rd base dugout.

A - Royals (1-1) -> #4 Bracket Seed (38 runs allowed)

B - Cubs (1-1) -> #2 Bracket Seed (29 runs allowed)

C - Orioles (1-1) -> #3 Bracket Seed (32 runs allowed)

D - Pirates (2-0) -> #1 Bracket Seed

E - Mariners (0-2)

- The third tiebreaker is total runs allowed in all tournament competition, with the lowest total runs being the winner.
- The final tiebreaker is a coin flip.
- No advantage will be given to a team running up the score.
- No regular season results factor into any of the tournament play.
- No additional games will be played to determine tournament seeding or advancement to the semi finals.
